

The terminal stop lies directly on one end of the urban square "Gravensteiner Platz". The architects had to work with a very narrow platform (only 4m) on which – due the the neccessary passage widths of 2m on either side – no furnishings were possible. Consequently the waiting arae with seatings and weather portection is located at the end of the platform under the wide area of the roof structure. The main interest oft he architecture was to create a thin, quiet an consequently elegant structure whilst maintaining all the necessary budgetary needs, functionality and robustness. 12 stainless steel roof elements consisting of upside down pyramids lie on the thin stainless steel columns. All the neccessary elements such as lighting and speaker fixtures are flushly integrated into the descretely folded roof structure, emphasising the appearance of the wing of an aircraft.
